Dear Pastors, Prayer Partners, Family & Friends,

As your missionaries to North Wales, it is always our desire to bring forth fruit to your account (Philippians 4:17). We are very excited to report that two teen girls (Koren Jones & Llio Jones, no relation) made a profession of faith on Sunday, April 22nd. What makes this even more exciting, is that this was the result of another one of our teen girls (Megan Owen-Ford) witnessing to them and then asking them to come to church on Sunday morning with her!! Koren and Llio (pronounced Klee-ah) have been coming to our Friday night outreach for years and began asking Megan some questions about what they had been hearing during our Friday night "God -Talks". They knew that Megan attended our church on Sunday mornings and the Teen Service on Sunday evenings. Megan is also being disciplined by Kim and is applying what she is learning by sharing her faith with her family and friends. What an encouragement it was to us when Megan came to us at the end of the Sunday morning service and told us that the girls wanted to talk with us about getting saved. Kim spoke with them for quite some time, but felt that it was best to have them go home and think about all they'd been told because they had absolutely no church background and the only things they really knew about God was what they'd been hearing on Friday nights. However, they called our home a couple of hours later and asked if they could come and talk with Kim some more because they really felt that they wanted to get saved and not put it off. Praise God!! Both girls were in church again this Sunday and were presented a Bible. The church also had a time of prayer over the girls. Please keep Koren and Llio in your prayers as they begin their walk with the Lord. Pray also for Megan, that she will continue to share her faith and be an example for our other teens and adults!!

Sunday, May 6th, we will be hosting a barbecue after the Sunday morning service. This is a great opportunity for our folks to invite their unsaved/unchurched family and friends. We will also be inviting the workers who installed the chapel heating, as well as, the workers who recently replaced some of the windows in the chapel. Steve Bender will be preaching and his wife, Jenelle, will be singing. Steve and Jenelle Bender, from the BBEI Missions Office, are visiting with us because Kim had arranged for Jenelle to speak for the BBFGB Ladies' Retreat here in Wales on May 2nd-4th. Please pray for these activities, those that attend and the seed that will be planted, that it will fall on fertile ground and take root.

As we close this letter, we need to report that we have had a very steep increase in postage rates here in the UK and in an effort to be better stewards, we feel we need to start sending our letter by e-mail. We have been doing it the hard copy way because we feel it is more personal and it was a way for us to individually pray for each of our supporters (financial & prayer) as we signed our letters.
