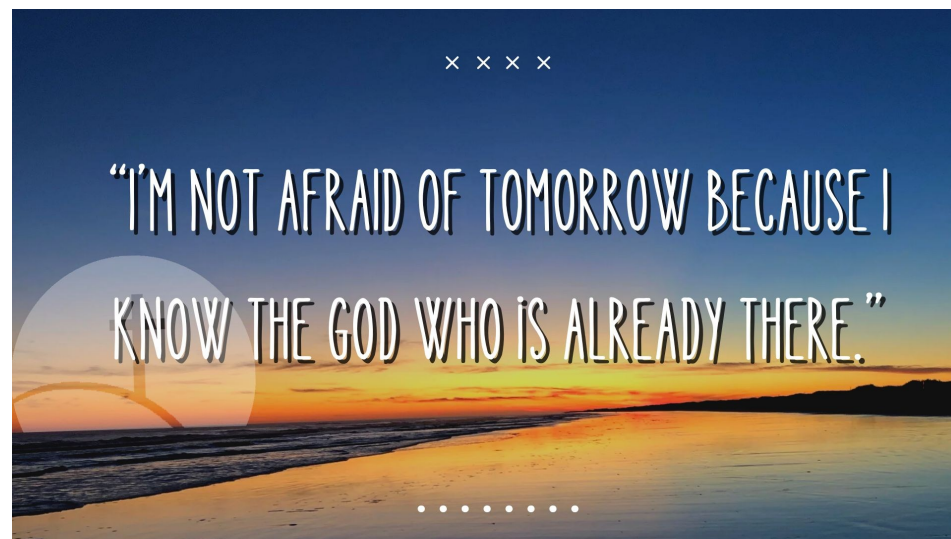


Sermon Notes:

Alvin & Haley Yankana—Missionaries in Guyana

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year from Guyana! We have only been here a little over a month, but wow—these first weeks have already been full and fruitful. On our way to church during our first week in Guyana, a rough looking young man called out my name. I slowly realized who he was. His name was Esau, once a faithful churchgoer who I'd met during my survey trip. He was now broken from a life of drugs. As he confessed his backsliding, he wept. I prayed with him and encouraged him to attend church that night—which he did. Please pray for Esau. I know the Lord desires to restore him, clean him up, and make him whole again. Christmas is the time of giving. God gave us a Savior, and we desire to share this gospel. On Christmas Eve, we decorated a canter truck with lights, ratchet-strapped a speaker to the roof, and went out caroling and preaching Jesus while distributing Bibles and John & Romans. Earlier that week we gave over 150 toys and meals to children while sharing the story of our Savior's birth. The joy on their faces is something I will never forget.

“Happy New Year!” We all hope it turns out that way, but in reality, we know there will be many times this year that fall somewhere between happy and depressing. Expect them and you won't be so surprised when they come. Aren't you glad our Lord is not surprised by the coming events?
