We continue to be involved over the border in Ukraine. The cities of Herson and Nikolaiev were freed from Russian occupation and the civilians were advised to move to safer cities. The threats are still present. The Russians continue to bomb different civilian areas. In the last shipment of food supplies (worth of \$4500), we bought 2,400 New Testaments in Ukrainian.
