At least 40 kids showed up and we were able to give them the gospel. Then we attended the University of Guam Charter Days Event held in the village of Mangilao. This was a great event where we got to pass out hundreds of tracts and witness to several people. In April, Pastor Barnes and I went soul winning, and the Lord blessed this effort by allowing us to lead two people, Jesse and Justin to Him. Praise the Lord! In April, we had our Bible clubs again, but this time we split up the workers and held one in an apartment complex just south of the Air Force Base. It was the first one that we had held in this area and the Lord worked mightily! We had 43 kids in attendance with several of them getting saved! Please be praying for this new Bible club.

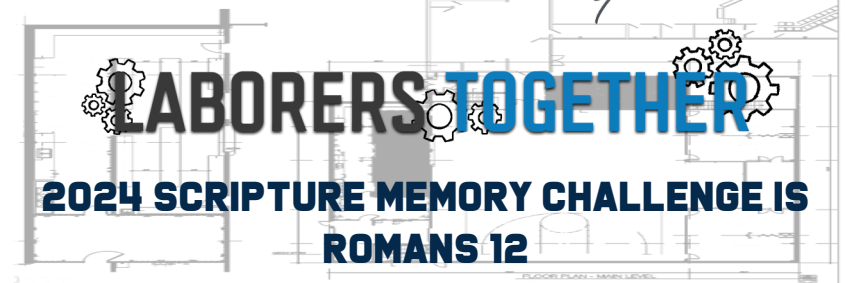


Sunday, May 5, 2024

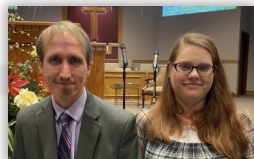
